**Permission to take or cause or permit to be taken photography at
aerodrome under rule 13 of the Aircraft Rules, 1937**


In exercise of the powers conferred under rule 13 of the Aircraft Rules, 1937, the aerodrome operator(s) is hereby permitted to take or cause or permit to be taken photography at security hold area and/or tarmac of the aerodrome licensed in its name, subject to the following conditions, namely:-

- (1) The aerodrome operator, shall ensure that photography, in any manner, whether, directly or indirectly, does not-
 - (a) endanger safety or security of an aircraft or aircraft operations;
 - (b) interfere with the normal functioning of any facility established for the safe and secure operation of aircraft or for the convenience and free movement of passengers and cargo;
 - (c) obstruct or distract any person entrusted with responsibilities relating to the safe and secure operation of aircraft or the aerodrome;
 - (d) lead to overcrowding within the aerodrome premises; and
 - (e) involve the erection of any structure within the premises of the aerodrome.
- (2) The person concerned shall carry identification documents and in addition entry permits issued as per the directions of the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security.
- (3) The person concerned shall undergo all security checks as applicable to

passengers when entering the airside.

(4) No foreign crew shall be engaged in the photography. Provided that in case foreign nationals are engaged in photography, it shall be ensured that such foreign nationals are security cleared from the concerned agencies for taking photography at the aerodrome.

(5) The Records of photography shall be maintained for a period of three years and shall be produced for inspection to the Directorate General of Civil Aviation upon demand.
